A bill to require a report on the operations of the State Justice Institute

As ordered reported by the House Committee on the Judiciary on July 24, 2001

H.R. 2048 would require the Attorney General to submit a report on the effectiveness of the State Justice Institute to the Committees on the Judiciary of the Senate and the House of Representatives by October 1, 2002. Based on information from the Department of Justice, CBO estimates that it would cost the agency less than \$500,000 in fiscal year 2002 to write and distribute the report. Because this bill would not affect direct spending or receipts, pay-as-you-go procedures would not apply. H.R. 2048 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
