**H. Con. Res. 36  
Urging increased federal funding for  
juvenile (Type I) diabetes research**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Energy and Commerce on July 18, 2001*

H. Con. Res. 36 would express the resolve of the Congress to increase annually federal funding of research to find a cure for juvenile diabetes, according to the recommendations of the Diabetes Research Working Group. CBO estimates that passing H. Con. Res. 36 would result in no significant cost to the federal government. The resolution would not affect direct spending or receipts; therefore, pay-as-you-go procedures would not apply.
