**H.R. 3217**

**A bill to provide for the conveyance of several small parcels of National Forest System land in the Apalachicola National Forest, Florida, and to resolve boundary discrepancies involving the Mt. Trial Primitive Baptist Church of Wakulla County, Florida**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Agriculture on October 29, 2003*

H.R. 3217 would authorize the U.S. Forest Service to convey, without consideration, about 10 acres of land in the Apalachicola National Forest, Florida, to the Mt. Trial Primitive Baptist Church. CBO estimates that conveying this property would have no significant impact on the federal budget. According to the Forest Service, the four parcels to be conveyed generate no receipts and are not expected to over the next 10 years.

The bill contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined by the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would have no significant impact on the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
