H.R. 326

**A bill to amend the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area Act of 2000
to adjust the boundary of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area**

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Resources on October 19, 2005

H.R. 326 would modify the boundary of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area in New Mexico to exclude certain private lands. CBO estimates that implementing this bill would have no impact on the federal budget because the federal government is not expected to ever acquire or manage the affected properties.

H.R. 326 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
