**S. 3051
National Park Service Special Resource Studies and Technical
Corrections Act of 2008**

*As reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources
on September 16, 2008*

S. 3051 would direct the National Park Service (NPS) to conduct special resource studies of two areas: the site of the Battle of Camden in South Carolina and the grounds of Fort San Geronimo in Puerto Rico. The studies, which would be completed over a three-year period, would determine the suitability and feasibility of adding the two areas to the National Park System.

Based on information provided by the NPS and assuming the availability of appropriated funds, CBO estimates that the agency would spend about \$500,000 over the 2009-2011 period to complete the two studies. Enacting S. 3051 would not affect direct spending or revenues.

The legislation contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
