**H.R. 8
Border Smog Reduction Act of 1998**

As cleared by the Congress on October 7, 1998

H.R. 8 would deny regular entry into the United States to certain operators of noncommercial motor vehicles registered in a foreign country that do not comply with state laws regarding motor vehicle emissions. Violators of the act's provisions would be subject to a civil fine of up to \$400. Enacting H.R. 8 could result in increased collections of civil fines, which are classified as revenues (governmental receipts), but CBO estimates that any such increase would be less than \$500,000 annually.
