2015 current status includes budget authority and outlays resulting from prior year appropriations. It reflects the latest stage of action, starting with the committee-reported stage.

The Budget Control Act of 2011 (P.L. 112-25) imposes caps on appropriations of new discretionary budget authority. This law allows for adjustments to the discretionary caps (and allows the Senate Committee on the Budget to adjust the 302(a) allocation) when appropriations are provided for certain purposes. Funding for OCO/GWOT and funding designated as an emergency requirement would lead to an increase in the caps. The caps would also be increased for disaster relief funding, but the adjustments would be limited on the basis of historical averages for such funding. The memorandum in the table above identifies the estimated amounts of the adjustments. In addition, the caps would be increased for program integrity funding, up to the limits provided in the Act (this adjustment will be shown in a footnote, when appropriate).

- Pursuant to section 115 of the Bipartisan Budget Act (P.L. 113-67), the Senate Committee on the Budget published committee allocations in the Congressional Record on May 5, 2014. The Senate Committee on Appropriations filed the 302(b) allocations on May 22, 2014 and updated them on June 16, 2014.
- In the Senate, the rescission of emergency funds in the State, Foreign Operations Appropriations Act (see Memorandum section) is excluded from current status.
- Pursuant to section 251 of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985. Disaster and overseas contingency operations funding is included in current status.
