The act includes a change in the Social Security Administration, limitation on administrative expenses account. \$2 million of nonemergency, unobligated balances were given a new purpose and designated as an emergency requirement. This change is reflected as a decrease in nonemergency and an increase in emergency budget authority and outlays.
