H. Con. Res. 88

**A concurrent resolution authorizing the use of the Capitol grounds
for the Greater Washington Soap Box Derby**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure
on March 13, 2014*

H. Con. Res. 88 would authorize the Greater Washington Soap Box Derby Association to use the Capitol grounds on June 14, 2014, or on such a date as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Senate Committee on Rules and Administration may jointly designate. Because the association would assume responsibility for all expenses and liabilities associated with the event, CBO estimates that passage of H. Con. Res. 88 would result in no significant cost to the federal government. Enacting the legislation would not affect direct spending or revenues; therefore, pay-as-you-go procedures do not apply.
