

CBO's Recent Publications and Work in Progress as of June 30, 2023

July 2023

To provide the Congress with a comprehensive review of its work, the Congressional Budget Office publishes quarterly reports, like this one, that highlight the agency's recent publications and summarize its work in progress.¹

Recent Work

Over the past three months, CBO has produced a variety of budget and economic analyses, fulfilling the agency's core mission of supporting the Congress during each stage of the legislative process.

The agency published 209 cost estimates for legislation that was reported by a committee or that was the subject of a motion to be placed on the consensus calendar. They included a letter, published on May 28, that discussed the estimated budgetary effects of the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023 (Public Law 118-5). That legislation imposes caps on discretionary funding, makes other changes that affect spending and revenues, and raises the debt ceiling. CBO estimated that if appropriations that are subject to caps on discretionary funding for 2024 and 2025 were constrained by the limits specified in section 101(a) of the law, the agency's projections of budget deficits would be reduced by about \$1.5 trillion over the 2023–2033 period relative to its May 2023 baseline. On May 9, CBO published a cost estimate for H.R. 2, the Secure the Border Act of 2023, which would limit the ability of the Department of Homeland Security to provide parole to foreign-born people without legal status. In addition, on May 23, CBO estimated the cost of S. 211, the SMART Leasing Act, which would establish a pilot program that would allow the General Services Administration to enter into long-term enhanced-use leases for certain underused, nonexcess real property.

Since CBO published its last quarterly report on the agency's work in progress, it has released 31 reports, working papers, and other analytic products (see Table 1 on page 6). A number of those products provided an analysis of the budgetary and economic situation in the United States. In May, the agency published *An Update to the Budget Outlook: 2023 to 2033*, which updated its projections of the federal budget for the next 10 years. The agency also published a report describing the debt limit and CBO's projection of when the federal government would no longer be able to pay its obligations in full if the limit was not increased or suspended. Later that month, CBO released *An Analysis of the Discretionary Spending Proposals in the President's 2024 Budget*, which compares the discretionary spending proposals in the President's 2024 budget with the agency's most recent baseline budget projections. Then, on June 28, the agency published its

budget projections and economic forecast for the next 30 years in *The 2023 Long-Term Budget Outlook*. In addition, each month since the previous update on the agency's work in progress, CBO issued its *Monthly Budget Review*, which is an analysis of federal spending and revenues for the previous month and the fiscal year to date.

CBO also produced two publications that provided information related to legislation addressing the debt ceiling. First, CBO responded to a request for information on the budgetary effects of proposed Medicaid work requirements under H.R. 2811, the Limit, Save, Grow Act of 2023.² Second, the agency produced a report on how the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023 affects CBO's projections of federal debt.

Other publications provided information about the budget:

- A visual report explaining the agency's Social Security projections;
- A report describing CBO's projections of the budgetary effects of automatic stabilizers—as well as the size of deficits without them—from 2023 to 2033; and
- The agency's annual report on programs whose authorizations of appropriations have expired or will expire.

Two publications examined the budgetary effects of alternative scenarios:

- A report explaining how CBO's most recent budget projections would change under different assumptions about future legislated policies; and,
- A report describing how changes in economic conditions might affect the agency's budget projections.

Two working papers explored topics related to macroeconomics:

- One investigated the inflationary effects of fiscal policy—specifically, the implications of supply disruptions and economic slack; and
- Another examined the role and economic effects of the U.S. dollar's status as an international currency.

Other publications presented analyses to inform policy discussion and debate:

- An update to the agency's regular report on its economic forecasting record;
- A visual report that provides an overview of issues surrounding the use of large constellations of low-altitude satellites for defense communications and observation;
- A description of the factors that explain trends in the economic profits of corporations and federal corporate income tax payments over recent decades;
- A report describing features of the Medicare and Medicaid improvement funds and how the funds are accounted for in CBO's baseline and cost estimates;

- A report assessing the quality of CBO's projections of federal outlays from 1984 to 2021;
- A report estimating the budgetary effects of options for expanding federal Medicaid payments to states for services provided to certain Medicaid enrollees who are treated in inpatient facilities known as institutions for mental diseases; and
- A report describing the foreign-born population in the United States and that population's effect on the U.S. economy and federal budget.

The agency also published various primers to help Congressional staff and the public understand budgetary concepts and the agency's processes. Those primers covered the following topics:

- CBO's method for estimating savings from rescissions;
- CBO's principles for identifying mandates in legislation;
- The statutory foundations of CBO's budget baseline;
- CBO's cost-estimating process; and
- The agency's process for developing its budget baseline.

In addition, CBO provided responses to questions from Members of Congress. On May 30, the agency published answers to questions for the record following a hearing on Social Security's finances. Then, on June 26, CBO published letters to the Chairmen of the House and Senate Budget Committees. One letter responded to questions about the agency's ongoing work—specifically, its macroeconomic analysis of legislation, its health care modeling, and its support for the legislative process. The other letter responded to questions about the agency's work assessing the risks associated with climate change and examining the effects that reforms to health care delivery systems have on costs and health outcomes.

Work in Progress

As of June 30, CBO was working on 141 cost estimates for legislation that had been ordered reported by a committee or that was the subject of a motion to be placed on the consensus calendar (see Table 2 on page 7). In addition, the agency was working on 23 analytic products that it expected to complete in the coming months.

Two products updating the agency's economic and budget projections were in progress as of June 30:

- A supplement to *The 2023 Long-Term Budget Outlook* describing the agency's economic and budget projections under alternative fiscal paths (to be released on July 20); and
- An update to the agency's economic projections for 2023, 2024, and 2025 (to be released on July 26).

Two recurring reports were in progress as of June 30:

- The Monthly Budget Review: June 2023 (to be released on July 11); and
- Estimates of the Cost of Federal Credit Programs in 2024.

Nine products requested by Members of Congress or required by law were in progress as of June 30:

- A report on the effects of discretionary funding caps on the economy and the budget (to be released on July 18);
- A report on the budgetary costs associated with nuclear weapons (to be released on July 14);
- A visual report describing types of special pay for the military;
- A visual report examining repayment patterns in the federal student loan program;
- A report that presents the distribution of household income, means-tested transfers, and federal taxes between 1980 and 2020;
- A visual report describing the government's exposure to flood risk through residential mortgage guarantee programs;
- A report summarizing the risks that climate change could pose for the federal budget and the economy;
- A report on the Navy's force structure; and
- A visual report on two military aircraft databases.

CBO has many other products in the research, drafting, and editing stages that support its mission of furnishing the Congress with timely analyses of policy issues.

Four publications will provide information on topics related to health care and health insurance:

- A visual report on federal subsidies for health insurance coverage;
- A short report that updates CBO's analysis of the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation;
- A short report describing CBO's approach to analyzing policies that would increase coverage of treatments for obesity; and
- A working paper describing the effects of Medicaid receipt during childhood on subsequent earnings in adulthood.

Three reports will provide analyses of environmental issues:

- A report on carbon capture and storage;
- A report evaluating the effects of climate change on markets for property and casualty insurance; and
- A visual report that summarizes how the prevalence of projected flood risk varies with communities' income and demographic characteristics.

Several products will explain or support the analytic methods used in CBO's work and budget estimates or provide background information:

- A working paper describing the modeling of electric vehicle demand;
- A report describing crop insurance and its budgetary effects; and
- A report on the administrative costs of federal credit programs.

Lists of CBO's forthcoming analytic reports and all of its published reports are available on the agency's website.³
