H.R. 5664

A bill to amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to update at least once every six years the plans and specifications for specially adapted housing furnished to veterans by the Secretary

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs
on April 30, 2008*

H.R. 5664 would require the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to provide eligible veterans with a handbook containing appropriate designs for specially adapted housing and to update the handbook at least every six years. Because VA currently provides veterans with such designs, CBO estimates that implementing the bill would have an insignificant effect on the budget.

H.R. 5664 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
