**H.R. 3332
Kalaupapa Memorial Act of 2008**

*As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources
on May 7, 2008*

H.R. 3332 would require the National Park Service (NPS) to allow a nonprofit organization to establish a memorial within Kalaupapa National Historical Park in Hawaii. The memorial would honor those who were forcibly relocated to the Kalaupapa Peninsula settlement for patients with Hansen's disease. Based on information provided by the NPS, CBO estimates that implementing the act would have no significant effect on the federal budget and no effect on direct spending or revenues. As required by the act, the Ka'Ohana O Kalaupapa, an organization of Hansen's patients and others, would construct and maintain the memorial at its own expense.

H.R. 3332 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would have no impact on the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
