**H. Con. Res. 335
Authorizing the use of the Capitol grounds
for a celebration of the 100th anniversary of
Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure
on May 15, 2008*

H. Con. Res. 335 would authorize the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, to use the Capitol grounds on July 17, 2008, or on such other date as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Senate Committee on Rules and Administration may jointly designate. Because the group would assume responsibility for all expenses and liabilities associated with the event, CBO estimates that adopting H. Con. Res. 335 would result in no significant cost to the federal government.
