**H.R. 1834**

**A bill for the relief of Mercedes Del Carmen Quiroz Martinez Cruz**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on the Judiciary on August 4, 1998*

H.R. 1834 would grant the status of immediate relative to Mercedes Del Carmen Quiroz Martinez Cruz, which would make it easier for her to obtain a family-sponsored immigrant visa. CBO estimates that enacting this legislation would have no significant impact on the federal budget. H.R. 1834 could have a very small effect on fees collected by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, which are classified as direct spending, so pay-as-you-go procedures would apply.
