**S. 2143**

**A bill to amend chapter 45 of Title 28, United States Code, to authorize the Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice to accept voluntary services, and for other purposes**

*As reported by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary on July 9, 1998*

Enacting S. 2143 would enable the Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice to accept voluntary personal services to assist with public and visitor programs. CBO estimates that S. 2143 would have no significant effect on the workload of the Supreme Court and thus, we estimate that enacting this bill would have no significant budgetary impact. Because S. 2143 would not affect direct spending or receipts, pay-as-you-go procedures would not apply.

S. 2143 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would have no impact on the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
