H. Con. Res. 279

Authorizing the use of the Capitol grounds for the 200th birthday celebration of the Library of Congress

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure on March 16, 2000

H. Con. Res. 279 would authorize the Library of Congress to use the Capitol grounds on April 24, 2000, or on such other date as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Senate Committee on Rules and Administration may jointly designate. CBO estimates that passage of H. Con. Res. 279 would result in no significant cost to the federal government.
