H.R. 3363

An act for the relief of Akal Security, Incorporated

As cleared by the Congress on September 28, 2000

H.R. 3363 would require the Security of the Treasury to pay Akal Security \$10,208.74 for security guard services provided to the Department of Defense in 1991. In addition, the legislation would extinguish a federal claim against Akal Security of \$57,771.29. That claim is for services paid for by the Department of Defense that it did not have the proper authority to pay. It is uncertain, however, when or if Akal Security will return the funds to the government under current law.
