## H.R. 519 San Gabriel River Watersheds Study Act

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on May 21, 2003

H.R. 519 would direct the Department of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the San Gabriel Mountains and the San Gabriel River and its tributaries. The act would direct the department to specifically consider the flood control, drainage, and wastewater treatment needs of the region. H.R. 519 would require the department to report its findings and recommendations within three years of receiving funding for the study.

Assuming the availability of appropriated funds, CBO estimates that it would cost less than \$500,000 over the next three years to complete the required study and report. Enacting this legislation would not affect direct spending or revenues.

H.R. 519 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
