**S. 339
Reaffirmation of State Regulation of Resident and Nonresident
Hunting and Fishing Act**

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary on April 21, 2005

S. 339 would affirm the authority of states to regulate fishing and hunting within their boundaries and to differentiate between residents and nonresidents when issuing permits and setting fees.

CBO estimates that enacting the legislation would have no effect on the federal budget. The bill contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
