H.R. 1239 **National Underground Railroad** **Network to Freedom Amendments Act of 2007**

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Natural Resources on June 28, 2007

SUMMARY

H.R. 1239 would authorize the appropriation of \$2.5 million a year to carry out activities of the National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom, a program administered by the National Park Service (NPS) that is dedicated to the preservation, interpretation, and dissemination of Underground Railroad history. Under the legislation, \$2 million of the amounts authorized for each year would be spent on NPS projects and \$0.5 million would be provided to nonfederal entities for historic preservation of eligible sites.

Assuming appropriation of the authorized amount, CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 1239 would cost \$2 million in 2008 and \$12.5 million over the 2008-2012 period. Enacting the legislation would have no effect on direct spending or revenues.

H.R. 1239 contains no private-sector or intergovernmental mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act (UMRA) and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.

ESTIMATED COST TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

The estimated budgetary impact of H.R. 1239 is shown in the following table. The costs of this legislation fall within budget function 300 (natural resources and environment).

BASIS OF ESTIMATE

For this estimate, CBO assumes that the legislation will be enacted before the start of fiscal year 2008 and that the authorized amount will be appropriated for each year.

H.R. 1239 would amend the National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom Act to authorize the appropriation of \$2.5 million per year to carry out activities under the program. The Network to Freedom encompasses over 250 programs, sites, and partners in 27 states and the District of Columbia. For fiscal year 2007, NPS received an appropriation of \$500,000 for that purpose.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND PRIVATE-SECTOR IMPACT

H.R. 1239 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in UMRA and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
