H.R. 3480

Let Our Veterans Rest in Peace Act of 2008

As ordered reported by the House Committee on the Judiciary on May 14, 2008

H.R. 3480 would require the United States Sentencing Commission to review and, if necessary, amend the federal sentencing guidelines for offenses involving the desecration, theft, or trafficking of veterans' grave markers or headstones. CBO estimates that implementing this bill would have no significant effect on the federal budget. Enacting H.R. 3480 would not affect direct spending or revenues.

H.R. 3480 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
