**A bill to redesignate the Rio Grande American Canal in El Paso, Texas,
as the "Travis C. Johnson Canal"**

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Natural Resources on June 25, 2008

H.R. 6041 would rename the Rio Grande American Canal in Texas. CBO estimates that implementing the bill would have no significant effect on discretionary spending because revising federal maps and signs to reflect the new name would be done in conjunction with scheduled reprinting and other routine maintenance. Enacting the bill would have no effect on direct spending or revenues.

The bill contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
