**A bill to grant a federal charter to Korean War Veterans
Association, Incorporated**

*As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary
on September 6, 2007*

S. 1692 would amend title 36 of the U.S. Code to grant a federal charter to the Korean War Veterans Association, Incorporated, a nonprofit veterans association. Because chartered organizations listed in title 36 are not agencies of the U.S. government and are conferred no federal benefits, CBO estimates that enacting this bill would have no impact on the federal budget.

S. 1692 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
