2012 current status includes budget authority and outlays resulting from prior year appropriations. It reflects the latest stage of action, starting with the committee-reported stage.

- On June 1, 2011 the House agreed to H. Res. 287. Section 2 of the resolution provided that H. Con. Res. 34 (the concurrent resolution on the budget for FY 2012 as passed by the House) shall have force and effect, pending the adoption of a conference report on the resolution. On June 1, 2011, the House Committee on Appropriations filed their first 302(b) allocation for 2012.

Pursuant to Sec. 301 of H. Con. Res. 34, on June 1 the House Committee on the Budget increased the allocation by \$258 million in BA and \$206 million in outlays (for H.R. 2017); on June 14 the Committee increased the allocation by \$118,684 million in BA and \$59,733 in outlays (for H.R. 2119).

- In accordance with section 3(c)(1) of H. Res. 5 and section 2 of H. Res. 287, amounts designated as an emergency requirement for FY 2012 shall not count for purposes of Sec. 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act. Therefore, they are excluded from this calculation.
