A bill for the relief of Corina de Chalup Turcinovic

As ordered reported by the House Committee on the Judiciary on April 30, 2014

H.R. 306 would make Corina de Chalup Turcinovic eligible for permanent U.S. residence. The bill would affect only one person and could have a very small effect on fees collected by the Department of Homeland Security; thus, enacting the bill would affect direct spending and pay-as-you-go procedures apply. However, CBO estimates that those effects would not be significant.
