H.R. 4751

A bill to make technical corrections to Public Law 110-229 to reflect the renaming of the Bainbridge Island Japanese American Exclusion Memorial, and for other purposes

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Natural Resources on July 16, 2014

H.R. 4751 would change the name of the Brainbridge Island Japanese American Memorial in the state of Washington to the Bainbridge Island Japanese American Exclusion Memorial. Based on information provided by the Department of the Interior, CBO estimates that implementing the bill would have no significant effect on the federal budget. Enacting H.R. 4751 would not affect direct spending or revenues; therefore, pay-as-you-go procedures do not apply.

H.R. 4751 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
