**H.R. 986  
Eightmile Wild and Scenic River Act**

*As ordered reported by the House Committee on Natural Resources on May 2, 2007*

H.R. 986 would designate a 25-mile portion of the Eightmile River in Connecticut as a scenic river under the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act. Based on information from the National Park Service, CBO estimates that the proposed designation would not significantly affect the agency's administrative or land-management costs, which are subject to appropriation. Enacting H.R. 986 would not affect direct spending or revenues.

H.R. 986 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
