**S. 3158  
Cape Cod National Seashore Advisory Commission  
Reauthorization Act**

*As reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources  
on September 16, 2008*

S. 3158 would extend the life of three commissions of the National Park Service (NPS), including the Cape Cod National Seashore Advisory Commission (through 2018), the National Park System Advisory Board (through 2010), and the Concessions Management Advisory Board (through 2009).

Based on information from NPS, CBO estimates that implementing S. 3158 would have no significant impact on the federal budget and would not affect direct spending or revenues. The three commissions, which advise the NPS on various matters, are scheduled to expire within the next few years. Currently, they receive, in total, less than \$400,000 a year from federal appropriations provided to the NPS.

S. 3158 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
