**H.R. 6073**

**An act to provide that federal employees receiving their pay  
by electronic funds transfer shall be given the option  
of receiving their pay stubs electronically**

*As reported by the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs  
on September 24, 2008*

H.R. 6073 would require the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) to provide federal employees that receive their pay through electronic transfer with the option of also receiving their pay stubs electronically. CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 6073 would have no effect on the federal budget because, according to OPM, all federal employees already have this option.

H.R. 6073 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.

On July 21, 2008, CBO provided a cost estimate for H.R. 6073, as ordered reported by the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform on July 16, 2008. The two pieces of legislation are identical as are the estimated costs.
