H.R. 5330 would extend a Department of Justice (DOJ) program that permits companies that have violated certain antitrust laws to admit guilt and assist in DOJ prosecutions of other companies alleged to have violated such laws. This program could increase the number of successful prosecutions and thus the amount of fines collected. CBO expects that any such additional fines would not be significant in any year.
