

**Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program—
CBO’s Estimate of the President’s Fiscal Year 2020 Budget**

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides benefits that help people in low-income households to purchase food. People generally are eligible for SNAP if they participate in certain other assistance programs, such as Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, or can demonstrate that their income and assets fall below certain thresholds. SNAP benefit amounts are based on a household’s net income and size. The maximum benefit is determined by the number of people in the household and the cost of the Thrifty Food Plan (a basket of foods identified by the Department of Agriculture as providing a nutritious diet) for a group of that size. CBO’s projections of outlays for SNAP benefits are based on the estimated number of participating households and their average benefits.

a. This policy was not sufficiently specified for CBO to make its own estimate of its effects on the budget. However, CBO included the Administration's estimates as a placeholder because the agency judged those estimates to be achievable targets for the budgetary effects of detailed policies that might be proposed in the future. However, CBO assumed that the policy would become effective in 2021.

b. The interaction between the policies to eliminate the LIHEAP and HCSUA link and to standardize state HCSUA amounts is included in the line for those policies. All other interactions are included in the line for interactions.

c. This policy also would result in child nutrition savings, which are included on this table.

d. This policy was not sufficiently specified for CBO to assess whether the proposal would result in costs or savings.
