



# CBO's Recent Publications and Work in Progress as of September 30, 2023

October 2023

To provide the Congress with a comprehensive review of its work, the Congressional Budget Office publishes quarterly reports that highlight the agency's recent publications and summarize its work in progress.<sup>1</sup> Over the past three months, CBO has produced a variety of budget and economic analyses, fulfilling the agency's core mission of supporting the Congress during each stage of the legislative process. The agency's work takes many forms, including cost estimates, testimonies, reports, and other analytic products.

## Recent Cost Estimates

CBO routinely provides the Congress with information about the effects of proposed legislation on the federal budget through its technical assistance and cost estimates.<sup>2</sup> The agency is required to prepare a cost estimate for nearly every bill that is approved by a full Congressional committee of the House of Representatives or Senate.<sup>3</sup> It also publishes cost estimates at other stages of the legislative process if requested to do so by a relevant committee or by Congressional leadership.

This past quarter, the agency published 202 cost estimates, including:

- A [cost estimate](#) for H.R. 3561, the PATIENT Act of 2023, which would expand price transparency requirements for hospitals, health insurers, and pharmacy benefit managers.
- A [cost estimate](#) for S. 10, the VA Clinician Appreciation, Recruitment, Education, Expansion, and Retention Support (CAREERS) Act of 2023, which would require the Department of Veterans Affairs to make several changes to its management of the department's health care workforce.
- A [cost estimate](#) for H.R. 485, the Protecting Health Care for All Patients Act of 2023, which would prohibit federal health care programs from using the quality-adjusted life year and similar measures to assess the relative value of medical interventions.

CBO also reviews [bills](#) scheduled to be taken up under suspension of the rules, which is a procedure that the House of Representatives uses on the floor to act on legislation expeditiously. CBO prepared 11 such estimates for those bills.

## Recent Analytic Products

Since CBO published its last quarterly report on the agency's work in progress, it has released 19 testimonies, reports, and other analytic products in addition to cost estimates (see [Table 1](#) on page 6).

A number of those products provided an analysis of the budgetary and economic situation in the United States:

- [Testimony](#) on the state of Social Security's finances;
- A [report](#) describing alternative scenarios for the economy and the budget;
- A [report](#) detailing the agency's recent projections of the economy; and
- [Testimony](#) on approaches to reducing the Department of Defense's compensation costs.

In addition, each month since the previous update on the agency's work in progress, CBO issued its *Monthly Budget Review* of federal spending and revenues for the previous month and the fiscal year to date.

Two publications provided information about the budget:

- One [report](#) analyzed the economic and budgetary effects of imposing caps on discretionary funding under H.R. 2811, the Limit, Save, Grow Act of 2023.
- A mandated [report](#) analyzed caps on discretionary budget authority and described why sequestration (the cancellation of budgetary resources) would not be necessary in fiscal year 2023.

Four publications explored topics related to national security and defense:

- One [report](#) presented the projected costs of nuclear forces over the 2023–2032 period, as required by statute.
- A [visual report](#) compared ways to measure the availability of F/A-18E/F Super Hornet aircraft using two Navy databases.
- A [slide deck](#) examined alternative ways of providing fuel to the military services, which face budgetary challenges when fuel prices rise.
- Another [visual report](#) analyzed funding for special and incentive pay for active-duty service members and how those types of pay have been used to address personnel shortfalls.

Two publications provided information on topics related to health care and health insurance:

- One [report](#) explored how the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Innovation's activities increased federal spending over the 2011–2020 period and are projected to do so again from 2021 through 2030.
- Another [report](#) provided estimates of health insurance coverage and federal subsidies for people of all ages, as well as people in U.S. territories, nursing facilities, and correctional facilities.

Other publications presented analyses to inform policy discussion and debate:

- A recurring [report](#) provided fair-value estimates of the cost of federal credit programs.
- Another [report](#) presented CBO's revenue and outlay projections for 2023 to 2033 as translated into the framework of the national income and product accounts (which are maintained by the Bureau of Economic Analysis) and their categories of current receipts and expenditures.
- A [working paper](#) presented a simulation model of the demand for electric vehicles.
- A [visual report](#) summarized how the prevalence of projected flood risk varies with communities' income and demographic characteristics.

CBO also provided responses to questions from Members of Congress:

- A [letter](#) to the Chairwoman and Ranking Member of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry, along with the Chairman and Ranking Member of the House Committee on Agriculture, describing CBO's efforts to provide budgetary analysis related to the reauthorization of the farm bill;
- A [letter](#) describing the agency's efforts to respond to a request for a cost estimate for the Primary Care and Health Workforce Expansion Act;
- [Answers to questions for the record](#) following a hearing on Social Security's finances;
- A [letter](#) with the agency's projections of gross federal debt through 2053; and
- [Answers to questions for the record](#) following a hearing on approaches to reducing the Department of Defense's compensation costs.

In addition, CBO published seven blog posts calling for new research in the areas of [energy and the environment](#), [finance](#), [health](#), [labor](#), [macroeconomics](#), [national security](#), and [taxes and transfers](#). The agency also posted [presentations](#) on its website that were given by CBO staff.

## Work in Progress

As of September 30, CBO was working on 194 cost estimates, nearly all of which are for legislation that has been approved by a committee (see [Table 2](#) on page 7). The agency also was working on 23 analytic products in addition to cost estimates that it expected to complete in the coming months.

Three recurring reports were in progress as of September 30:

- The [Monthly Budget Review: September 2023](#) (released on October 10);
- A report analyzing the cost and force structure of the Navy's fiscal year 2024 shipbuilding plan; and
- A report projecting the costs of the Department of Defense's plans for 2024 through 2038 as presented in the 2024 Future Years Defense Program.

Eight requested products were in progress as of September 30:

- A visual report on student loan repayment;
- A visual report presenting the distribution of household income, means-tested transfers, and federal taxes in 2020 and a companion document examining the associated trends from 1979 through 2020;
- A visual report describing the government's exposure to flood risk through residential mortgage guarantee programs;
- A report summarizing the risks that climate change could pose for the budget and the economy;
- A visual report estimating the Navy's costs to eliminate its deferred maintenance backlog and to renovate and modernize its buildings;
- A report comparing the earnings, personal income, and household income of working-age veterans who receive disability compensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs with those of veterans who do not receive such compensation;
- A report analyzing how housing allowances provided to military personnel compare with the amount that comparable civilians spend on housing; and
- A report assessing alternative approaches to reducing prescription drug prices.

CBO has many other products in the research, drafting, and editing stages that support its mission of furnishing the Congress with timely analyses of policy issues.

Two publications will provide information on topics related to health care and health insurance:

- A report describing CBO's approach to analyzing policies that would increase coverage of treatments for obesity; and
- A working paper describing the effects of receiving Medicaid benefits during childhood on subsequent earnings in adulthood.

Four publications will provide analyses of environmental issues:

- A report on carbon capture and storage;
- A report evaluating the effects of climate change on markets for property and casualty insurance;
- A working paper describing the agency's approach to modeling policies in the electric power sector; and
- A report providing information on trends in greenhouse gas emissions from the manufacturing sector.

Several products were in progress as of September 30 that explain the analytic methods used in CBO's work or provide background information:

- A report describing crop insurance and its budgetary effects;
- A report on the administrative costs of federal credit programs;
- A report on risk sharing in federal credit programs;
- A working paper describing how CBO generates economic scenarios using alternative values for certain variables, such as the rate of inflation or interest rates;
- A [slide deck](#) illustrating how CBO projects corporate income tax revenues (published on October 5); and
- An infographic about military compensation.

CBO's upcoming releases and published reports are available on the agency's website.<sup>4</sup>

The Congressional Budget Office prepares this report each quarter to help keep the Congress informed about the agency's work.
