H.R. 1727 would extend the authorization of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal National Historical Park Commission through September 30, 2034. Under current law, that authority expires on September 26, 2024. Commission members would serve without compensation; however, the Department of Interior may cover the costs for certain incidental expenses. Based on the costs of similar activities, CBO estimates that implementing the bill would cost less than \$500,000 over the 2024-2028 period. Any spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.

On November 20, 2023, CBO transmitted a <u>cost estimate for S. 924</u>, the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal National Historical Park Commission Extension Act, as ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on September 21, 2023. The two bills are similar, and CBO's estimates of their budgetary effects are the same.
