The amounts included reflect CBO's estimates for the legislation at the time it was considered. This report does not include CBO's estimate for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (P.L. 111-5, enacted on February 17, 2009). The "Request"

column only includes estimates of budget amendments or requests for supplemental appropriations transmitted by the administration that contained proposed statutory language for their requests.

- a. Division I (the Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2018) would provide \$1.68 billion in supplemental funding for fiscal year 2019, and would designate those amounts as emergency requirements pursuant to section 251 of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (Deficit Control Act). (The limits (or caps) on discretionary spending established for 2019 by the Budget Control Act of 2011, as amended by the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018, would be adjusted to accommodate those amounts.) In general, the budgetary effects of authorizing legislation are recorded as direct spending or revenue. However, consistent with the language in Division I, and at the direction of the House and Senate Committees on the Budget, this estimate treats the budgetary effects of Division I as discretionary spending.
- b. Subdivision 1 of Division B of P.L. 115-123 (the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018) contains the Further Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act, 2018.
- c. Division B of P.L. 115-96 (An Act to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to require the Secretary of Homeland Security to issue Department of Homeland Security-wide guidance and develop training programs as part of the Department of Homeland Security Blue Campaign, and for other purposes) contains the Department of Defense Missile Defeat and Defense Enhancements Appropriations Act, 2018, which provided \$4,686 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2018 for missile defense.
- d. Division B of P.L. 115-56 (Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act, 2017) provided \$15,250 million in budget authority for fiscal year 2017. Section 141 of Division D of P.L. 115-56 (Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018) rescinded and reappropriated an estimated \$20 million in unobligated balances previously provided in P.L. 113-2 (Disaster Relief Appropriations Act of 2013 and Sandy Recovery Improvement Act of 2013).
- e. Division B of P.L. 114-254 (Security Assistance Appropriations Act, 2017) provided \$10,075 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2017 for overseas contingency operations.
- f. Division B of P.L. 114-223 (Zika Response and Preparedness Act, 2017) provided \$1,108 million in budget authority in fiscal year 2016; the President requested \$1,797 million. Division C (Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017) provided \$500 million in fiscal year 2016 for disaster relief and Division D (Rescissions of Funds) rescinded \$400 million in previously appropriated budget authority; the President did not request additional amounts for disaster relief or propose amounts for rescission.
- g. In this legislation, Congress did not consider \$5,360 million in budget authority requested by the President, including amounts for certain settlement payments, response to Gulf Coast oil spills, and border security.
- h. P.L. 111-224 provided \$129 million in fiscal year 2010 for salaries and expenses of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (PTO) and rescinded \$129 million from the fiscal year 2010 appropriation for Periodic Censuses and Programs. The President requested an additional \$139 million in budget authority for fiscal year 2010 (\$10 million for the National Telecommunications and Information Administration, and \$129 million for salaries and expenses of PTO) and proposed a rescission of \$139 million from Periodic Censuses and Programs.
- i. This act expanded the scope of an existing appropriated entitlement (compensation for veterans affected by Agent Orange). The President requested, and the act provided, an additional \$13,377 billion in mandatory budget authority for this purpose.
- j. P.L. 110-252 provided \$115,808 million in supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2008 and \$85,155 million in supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2009; each of those amounts is shown within each respective fiscal year in this table.
- k. P.L. 109-174 transferred \$712 million in budget authority that was originally provided in P.L. 109-62 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Disaster Relief Fund to the Small Business Administration's disaster loan program. The President requested \$1,254 million in additional budget authority.

- l. The President requested \$10,276 million for fiscal year 2004 and \$1,579 million in fiscal year 2005; for comparison purposes, both of those amounts are shown in the request column for fiscal year 2005.
- m. The President requested \$25 billion for fiscal year 2005 to support operations in Iraq and Afghanistan; these funds were instead provided for fiscal year 2004 in P.L. 108-287. For comparison purposes, the request is shown in fiscal year 2004.

- n. On July 8, 2003, the President requested \$1,550 million in supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2003 for the Department of Homeland Security's Disaster Relief Fund. Congress provided a combined \$1,425 million for this purpose in two laws: \$984 million in P.L. 108-69, and then an additional \$442 million in P.L. 108-83. The President's request for disaster relief is shown in the entry for P.L. 108-69.
